Procedure: Students should submit the following documents to the school Scholarship Coordinator:

1. A scholarship resume or curriculum vitae
2. A transcript of grade 11 and grade 12 marks, including predictions for the last courses of grade 12
3. Proof of acceptance at a post-secondary institution
4. Letter of recommendation from a faith group (church of any denomination)
5. Letter of recommendation from teacher or community leader
6. A statement of future plans and goals
