“My divorce really humanized my parents for me and that song, writing it, made me just kind of get over things that my own parents did or didn’t do for me.”

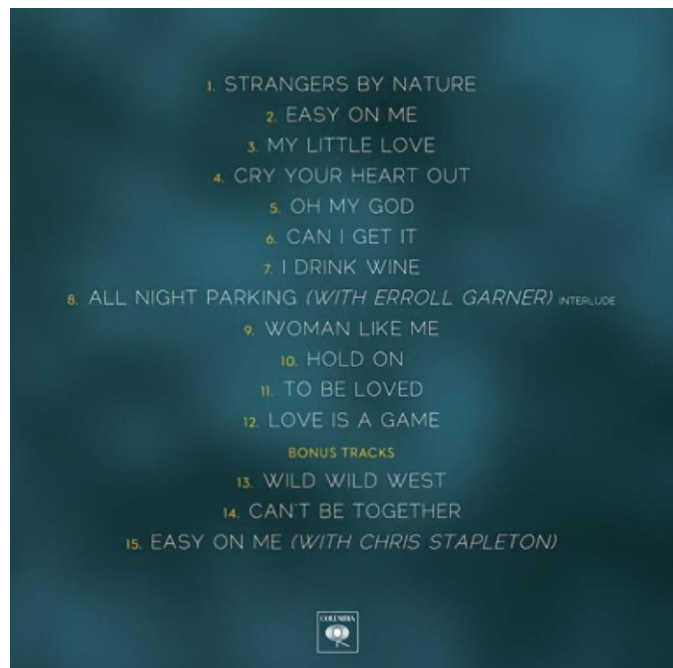
“I feel like it was important for me to tell Angelo’s story and be like, it was hard; and I wasn’t doing a very good job at the most wild moment of his life probably.”

Every single track has its own story and catch but “*Easy On Me*” and “*My Little Love*” are probably my favorite songs on this album.

The song “*Easy On Me*” just shows such a kind of

explanatory side of her and really gives you a look inside and a perspective on her side of the story and what weighs her down. Plus, the absolutely wonderful emphasis on her in-depth vocals over the piano instrumentation always catches me and gets me to just feel the song.



Whereas *“My Little Love”* totally captures my heart in a very intimate and innocent way.

Listening to her audio recordings in between and hearing her honest and raw emotions, makes me feel like I’m not just a stranger listening to a song but rather someone who listens to a heartfelt and emotional story of a friend that just needs somebody to hear her.

Album Success and Awards



With “30” being the fourth studio album released by the English singer-songwriter, it is only well deserved to be nominated for six **Grammy Awards**, including **Album of the Year** and it winning the **Brit Award for British Album of the Year** at the **Brit Awards 2022**.
