- VCPAC is aware of and supportive of the Parent Education event
- October minutes from VCPAC show the focus on how equity and inclusion are measured in schools and across programs of choice. This isn't equity as in the case of every kid has a seat in the classroom - it's what are the learning outcomes and what kinds of in-class events impact that and do they differ between

regular classes and programs of choice. An example that has been given is: how many times do classes have to evacuate a classroom because of a student (that student stays and the rest of the class has to leave the room for safety) and does that happen with equal frequency in programs of choice?

- VCPAC has several FOI requests out to the District for details regarding incidents involving students. They have learned there is no consistent tracking across schools.
