- Positive start to the school year
- Enrolment:
 - o just under 1,200 students; classes are very full
 - Attendance is declining and administration is investigating why students are missing/avoiding; this a priority and goal to change. Absences have been increasing generally since COVID.
- Coming up this Month:
 - o Presentation of theatrical play coming up based on Holocaust survivors' experiences
 - o Thanksgiving, Parent Teacher interviews (October 17) and Pro D day (October 25) coming
- Learning updates: student goal setting and reflections will take place in next two weeks and be for the entire school year related to school goals, personal, community
 - o Addition of 20 min to block B where goal setting will take place
- Athletics:
 - o Football: first win! October 31 game against Mt. Doug
 - o Volleyball: lots of games, hosted four tournaments, two more tournaments to go
 - Soccer, Cross Country, and Rowing are underway; Basketball Tryouts in progress; Curling is a winter sport and will take place from November to February
- Leadership
 - Cops for Cancer raised over \$12,000 through activities including a carwash, BBQ, Grad shaving cream fight
- Athletic Leadership
