
The Eminem Show

General information:

Eminem's real name is Marschall Bruce Mathers III: He was born on October 17, 1972 in St. Joseph, Missouri in the US. He is 52 years old today. His parents are Deborah R. Nelson Mathers and Marshall Bruce Mathers jr. He has three siblings and three daughters. His artist name was made from putting the initials of his first and last name together (M&M) and spelling it out as Eminem. In his songs he also created an alter ego called slim shady.

Upbringing:

Eminem was raised by his mother, as his father left, when he was still a young child. His mother often moved, which led to him having to change schools multiple times a year. In multiple songs he also describes his mother as a drug addict and blames her for his struggles with addiction later on in life. He also got Bullied in school and dropped out at 17. He was later discovered by Dr. Dre and released his first album, called "The slim shady LP" in 1999, which was immediately a success.


General info on the album:

The Eminem show is Eminem's fourth studio. Album and was released on May 26, 2002. It's total time is one hour, 17 minutes and 32 seconds. It was recorded from 2001 to 2002 and is in the genre of hip-hop. The lapels of the album, were Shady records, Aftermath and Interscope. Songs from the album that were released as singles are Without Me, Cleanin' Out My Closet, Superman, Sing for the Moment and Business.

Success of the album:

The Eminem Show debuted at number one on the billboard 200and stood there for six nonconsecutive weeks. It also topped the UK Album charts for five consecutive weeks. Copies of it were sold over 1.3 million times in its second week in the US. The album was the best-selling album of 2002 in the US and the world. The Eminem Show was certified 12 times platinum by the Recording industry association of America (RIAA). The worldwide sales of the album are 27 million copies, which makes it one of the best-selling albums of all time and the second bestselling album of the 21-century. All of this makes it The Eminem Show Eminem's most commercially successful album.






Songs:

Without Me 7/10: Without Me is Eminem's most streamed song on the album . The music video of without me also received MTV Video Music Awards for Video of the Year, Best Male Video, Best Rap Video and Best Direction. The Video also won Best Short Form Music Video at the Grammy Awards of 2003.
