
Kesha's Rainbow

About the Artist:

Kesha rose sebert, (born

March 1st 1987, Los Angeles California U.S.). Her first rise to success was when she made her debut on Flo-Rida's song "Right Round" in 2009. Kesha's mother Pebe was a singer-songwriter, she would often take both Kesha and her brothers along to recording studios and encouraged Kesha to sing with her after noticing her talent. Her mom taught her how to write songs and they often wrote songs together after school. She co-wrote with her mom a song called "Stephan" when she was 16. In 2013 she sold over 33 million combined tracks and ringtones in the U.S. alone and 55 million worldwide. Before she dropped out of high school, like me she was in band, she played the trumpet and later on the saxophone. She and her family were also on an episode of the American reality Tv show called *The simple life*, which aired in 2005.

"Woman"

This song is a great example of the female empowerment she intended. The song was inspired by a rather inappropriate comment made by Donald Trump and Billy Bush. While the two were discussing the topic of women, Trump states "I don't even wait. And when you're a star, they let you do it. You can do anything...Grab 'em by the P****. When Kesha heard that she was so very upset that she shouted "I'm a motherf***ing Woman", which she repeats throughout the song. I love the funky-powerful trumpet sounds within the chorus!. In the music video she's just having fun at a club with her friends, being herself, and letting all the men there know that she;s the boss and she's not going to let them play her.

"Learn to let go"




Kesha has been through a number of Hardships in her life. Both this album and Her album called Warrior was put on hold

during the court case ruling in which she accused her past producer Dr. Luke of physical, sexual, and emotional abuse and discrimination of employment against her. The case was settled in June 2023. She was put through rehab a few times, in which she occasionally had ideas for other songs she's written, she grew up in poverty where she and her family sometimes relied on theft, she

experienced eating disorders, along with not knowing who her father was. In her 2012 autobiography she says: "I remember it being fun to be broke when I was a kid. I love making something beautiful out of things that others have thrown away". When I first heard this song I was not in a very good state of mind, and it said something to me that I really needed to hear at the time. On occasion when I listen to this song it helps remind me that sometimes you just have to let things go and forgive yourself. The music video starts out with her putting in a VHS tape, and a video of her as a child shows up. Throughout the video she's walking through a forest and everywhere she goes she finds an object that symbolizes something from her past.


Ex: "The past can't haunt me if I don't let it live and learn and never forget it"
